

How to Help Your Child Reach His or Her Potential

Reading

Please read with your child every day. Help him or her with both fluency and comprehension. Complete the Weekly Reading Log and return it, inside the Homework Folder, on Fridays.

Encourage your child to play the "Learning Path" ("To Do") i-Ready reading activities.

The i-Ready program assesses your child's progress and personalizes instruction and activities based on your child's current needs. This program is available for reading and math. See below for details.

Encourage your child to regularly take Accelerated Reader tests on the books that he or she reads.

Your child's user name is his or her **first initial** and the **first four letters of their last name**.

Math

Access the i-Ready math curriculum and encourage your child to regularly play the "Learning Path" ("To Do") math activities. See below for the login information.

Bring your child to Math Tutorial every Thursday morning, 8:30 to 9:15.

Ensure your child regularly corrects his or her assignments and assessments for extra credit.

Encourage your child to play multiplication games, using his or her multiplication chart.
