What we are learning this week:

- Math: Multiply by 0, 1, 2, 5, and 10. We will start learning, and eventually memorizing, multiplication facts!

How you can help at home: Practice, practice, practice those multiplication facts! Look on Woodriver's third grade website, www.wolfpups.org, for many free resources to help.

- Reading: We will read a narrative nonfiction story, Bat Loves the Night. We will practice the skill of sequencing story events, or putting the parts of the story in the correct order. We will also do some activities continuing last week's skill practice, identifying cause and effect.
- Writing & Grammar: We will identify action verbs, and start learning about the different forms of the verb, "to be."
- Science: We will use cloud types to predict weather, and practice reading a thermometer while analyzing temperature data.
