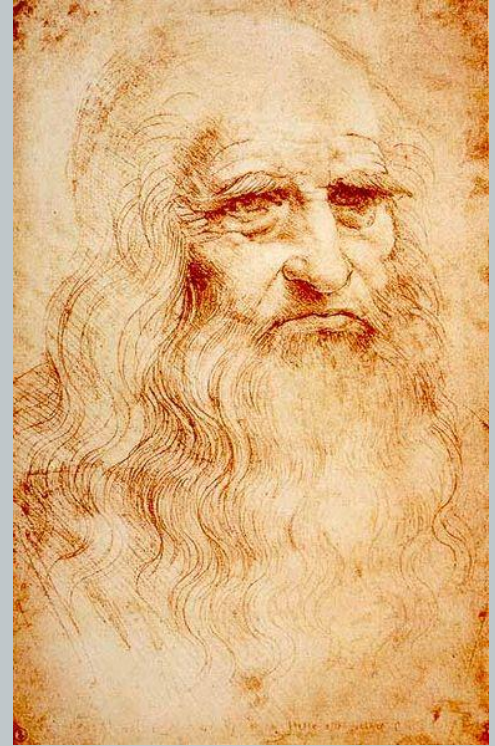


Comparisons
