The students will need to pick up their displays on Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 1 PM.

The Science Fair is an awesome opportunity to explore a topic of interest and share your findings with the entire school and community. Everyone is strongly encouraged to participate. All participants will receive a certificate, participant ribbon, and a button. Winners will be selected in each category and they will receive ranked ribbons.
