Synopsis

Congratulations! You are going to create your first book report. A book report is an opportunity to share what you learned about a book with others. You will provide facts and share your opinions. There are many variations of books reports. This assignment will focus on the basics.

Structure

A book report usually consists of, at least, two parts. A written report and a visual display. To complete the written report, you will answer questions and share your opinions. Your display will be a poster. Your poster will include, at least, three hand drawn color pictures with captions. A caption is a summary of what is happening in the picture.

Theme

The main subject that is being discussed or described in the story.

Plot

The sequence of events that make up a story. What happens in the story.

Genres

The story's category. It is a true story (nonfiction) or made up (fiction)?

drama (play) fable (focus on animals acting like people) science fiction poem

fantasy tall tale (an exaggeration of what could really happen) mystery


comedy myth (explains historical events in a fantastic way, may involve gods)

biography (someone's life story. It's an autobiography when the subject is the author)






