- 1. Write your name, number, date, and title on your story.
- 2. Use your best handwriting.
- 3. Look up words that you don't know how to spell.
 - a. If Mr. Kinder corrects a misspelled word, please write it in "My Writing Words" so you always know how to spell it.
- 4. Always begin sentences with capital letters. Use capital letters for names and for the word I.
 - a. Do NOT use capital letters for anything else.
- 5. Use periods to end sentences.
 - a. A sentence is one complete thought.
 - b. It will have a subject and a predicate.
- 6. Do NOT begin sentences with the words then, so, because, or and.
- 7. Put space between words, about the width of a pencil.
- 8. Write margin to margin.
- 9. Read your story out loud to yourself. Does it make sense?
- 10. Carefully read the feedback on your story and never make the same mistake twice.
